

THE DYLAN LEWIS SCULPTURE GARDEN
TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entry is at own risk , management will hold no responsibility for any loss , damage or injury whatsoever and whenever caused, arising from admission to the Sculpture Garden.

All visitors are required to abide by the following rules in the interest of safety and respect for other visitors and the Sculpture Garden environment.

- Visits and tours are by appointment only.
- Children under the age of 16 (including school students) are to be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Suitable footwear is to be worn at all times to protect against injury.
- The Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden is an outdoor environment and as such visitors are responsible for their own safety at all times.
- No food or beverages are to be brought into the Sculpture Garden, unless permission is granted by management.
- Smoking is prohibited in the Sculpture Garden.
- The hosting of private events, ceremonies, and/or commercial photo/film shoots is by permission of management only. Requests to info@dylanart.co.za .
- Photography for private or non-commercial use is permitted, however any commercial use will require express permission from management. Requests to info@dylanart.co.za .
- Climbing onto sculpture's is strictly prohibited.
- Guide Dogs and other registered assistance dogs are the only animals permitted, and prior warning is required.
- All visitors are to conduct themselves in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of Management, does not disrupt or offend other persons within the Sculpture Garden.

Management reserves the right refuse entry to, exclude or remove any person from the Sculpture Garden, or any part of the premises managed or controlled by the Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden.
